

At-Home COVID-19 Exposure

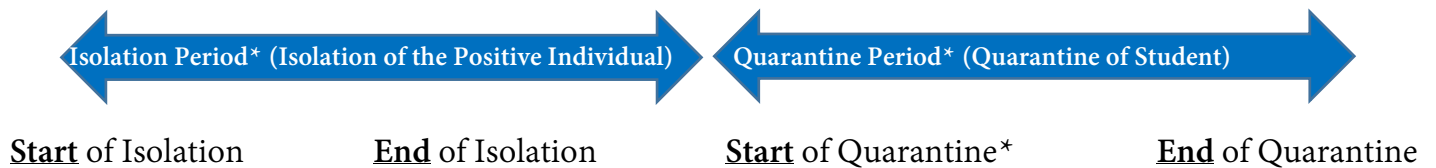
All Grades

For Fully Vaccinated Students:

Quarantine is not required following an at-home COVID-19 exposure. Fully vaccinated students without symptoms may remain in school and participate in all school activities.

For Unvaccinated Students:

At-Home Quarantine Period (**Remains at home**)



Criteria to End at-home Quarantine:

Criteria 1: The unvaccinated student is unable to start their five-day quarantine period until the COVID-19 positive member of the household meets the California Department Public Health criteria to exit isolation. During this time the student must also quarantine home. Once this period is over the student must quarantine at home for an additional five days.

Criteria 2: After the unvaccinated student completes 5 days of at-home quarantine, the unvaccinated student is eligible to return to school if they do not have any symptoms and test negative on a COVID-19 test. If a student is positive on a COVID-19 test, or is unable/refuses to test, the individual must isolate for the full 10 days before returning to school.

*The start of the quarantine period is dependent on the isolation length of the COVID-19 positive individual.
